

Council on American Indian Concerns  
Minutes  
Specially Called Teleconference Meeting,  
10:00 am, November 26, 2007

Council members in attendance via telephone: Nealie McCormick, Marilyn McGaughey, Tom Gresham, Ralph Crews, Sarah Hill, Bobby Tuggle and Royce McCrary

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Nealie McCormick at 10:02 am.

The only order of business was the adoption or rejection of the report on the factional dispute among the Georgia Tribe of Eastern Cherokee prepared by Henry Flood and sent to Council members by mail about a month earlier.

Sarah Hill offered a motion to accept the report and the Georgia Attorney General's review of the report.

The chairman asked for discussion and there was none. The Chairman then asked for a roll call vote on the motion, the results of which were:
